

Services and Pricing at Urgent Care

We provide a variety of basic treatments, services & diagnostic testing for patients who need medical care and cannot get in to see their physician. Our average visit will cost around \$103-\$142. This is a baseline fee. Please see below for details on treatments, procedures, and additional pricing.

Please note that payment is expected at the time of service.

Common Treatments	
Coughs, Colds, Flu, Sore Throats & Sinus Infections	These are common conditions and will be examined to determine the cause and appropriate treatment in each case.
Minor Cuts, Scratches, Sprains & Strains	See more about laceration repair in the next section, under "procedures."
Urinary Tract Infections	Relief from these common infections is important. We can determine the best treatment and the location of the infection.
Ear & Eye Infections	We will treat both middle and outer ear infections in patients of all ages, along with common eye problems.
Minor Aches & Pains	Not sure what's wrong? We can help you pinpoint the cause and source of your minor pain.
Minor Allergy & Asthma Issues	Some minor allergy and asthma issues can be treated simply with medications or breathing treatments. For severe allergic reactions or breathing problems, please call 911.
Fractures	We have X-ray onsite, see more about this procedure under "tests." We can treat minor sprains and fractures and help with referrals to orthopedic specialists.
Minor Stomach Problems	We will determine the cause of your stomach discomforts including nausea, vomiting and diarrhea. Additional testing may be necessary depending on your symptoms.
Minor Work Injuries	For minor injuries occurring at work, immediate medical care can be necessary.

Common Procedures	
Laceration Repair	We can repair small cuts and lacerations. The cost for this ranges from \$250-\$500 depending on site on body and depth of the wound.
Abscess Incision & Drainage	Treatment of red, inflamed skin wounds can vary depending on condition of the wound. The cost for this treatment ranges from \$175-\$350.
Breathing Treatment	Nebulizer breathing treatments are available to help clear airways. The cost is approximately \$70.

Common Tests	
EKG	The electrocardiogram test can be performed onsite. The cost is \$115.
Chest X-ray	This common radiographic test costs \$197. Radiologist's fee: \$67
X-ray of Lumbar Sacral Spine	This test can be done to help diagnose an injury. Lumbar X-Ray \$422. Radiologist's fee: \$53
	Other common radiographic tests range from \$100-\$350*.
Urine Pregnancy Test	A common and simple test, the cost is \$47.
Urinalysis	This common test is used to diagnose various conditions, depending on symptoms. The cost is \$39.
Strep Screening	Testing for Strep Throat. The cost is \$29.
Influenza	Testing for the Influenza virus. The cost is \$59 for each strain.
Flu Shot	Flu shots are available for for \$34. For infants and children age 4 and under, we recommend visiting a pediatrician's office.
Sports Physical	The exam helps determine whether it's safe for your child to participate in a particular sport. \$47
DOT Physical	This exam meets Department of Transportation requirements (includes Urine Analysis). \$142
Average Office Visit	An average office visit cost is \$149.
