
# **MEET OUR LEADERSHIP**



# **OUR HEALTHCARE SERVICES**



#### **ADDICTION & INTERNAL MEDICINE**

At Sheridan Memorial Hospital's Addiction and Internal Medicine Clinic, we provide hope and healing for patients suffering from substance abuse and addiction issues. Our specially trained staff provides continuity of care and medical treatment for patients



experiencing opiate/narcotic/methamphetamine addiction, stimulant and alcohol abuse, tobacco, gambling, and other addiction issues. The team works locally with community mental health professionals, offering a collaboration of services for patients who seek help with addiction.







#### **BIG HORN SURGICAL**

We have a team of board-certified surgeons available to perform elective, urgent, and trauma surgeries. Knowing you don't have to travel to receive quality surgical care reduces the stress on you and your loved ones. To meet the growing healthcare needs of our community, we work hard to develop and expand available surgical services and deliver the care you can trust. Our goal is to provide access to technology and services exceeding



what you might expect in a rural area like Sheridan County. The team at Big Horn Surgical diagnoses, treats, and manages a broad spectrum of surgical conditions from minimally invasive to complex surgical procedures affecting almost any area of the body.



#### **ROBOTIC-ASSISTED SURGERY**

Sheridan Memorial Hospital continually strives to provide leading-edge surgical care and, now, with the acquisition of the da Vinci® Robotic-Assisted Surgical System, our highly trained surgeons can perform many types of complex, delicate procedures for a wide



range of conditions with more precision, flexibility, and control than is possible with conventional techniques. Surgeries include hernia repair, hysterectomy, endometriosis, gall bladder removal, ovary removal, and prostate biopsy/removal.

#### **CLOUD PEAK SLEEP LAB**

Cloud Peak Sleep Specialists is a joint venture between Sheridan Neurology and Sheridan Memorial Hospital. Polysomnography, also referred to as a sleep study, is a test used to diagnose sleep disorders such as obstructive sleep apnea, narcolepsy, and unexplained chronic insomnia. During a sleep study, sleep patterns are monitored through the



recording of brain waves, blood oxygen levels, heart rate, and breathing. Eye and leg movements are also tracked. Sleep studies are important because untreated sleep disorders can raise your risk for heart disease, high blood pressure, stroke, and other medical conditions.



#### EAR, NOSE & THROAT (ENT) / AUDIOLOGY

Sheridan Memorial Hospital's Ear, Nose & Throat clinic offers compassionate, specialized care to diagnose and treat a broad range of conditions. When you suffer from ailments affecting your ears, nose, and throat, you are not at your best. Our Ear, Nose and Throat staff are committed to enhancing your day-to-day life by providing pediatric and adult



patients with a broad range of medical and surgical treatments. Allow us to help you manage conditions such as sinus infections, tonsil and adenoid problems, allergies, nasal airway obstruction, voice problems, ear infections, hearing loss, balance disorders, and other ear problems.

#### **HEART CENTER / CATH LAB**

Every day in Wyoming, more than 50 people are diagnosed with heart disease. You can trust us with your heart health. With a cardiac catheterization lab and Heart Center, as well as our state-of-the-art ICU and cardiac rehabilitation services, heart patients receive comprehensive heart care right here in Sheridan. Cardiac care at Sheridan Memorial Hospital focuses on you, utilizing a coordinated effort with a patient-centered team led by the physicians and advanced practice clinicians at the Heart Center. You will be supported through every step of



your care and provided an individualized treatment plan. Our dedicated staff are available to answer all of your questions throughout your treatment and follow-up visits. We are here, close to home, and will provide you with excellent cardiac care.



#### CARDIAC REHAB

Cardiac rehab is a medically supervised program designed to improve your cardiovascular health if you have experienced heart attack, heart failure, angioplasty (coronary stent), or heart surgery. Cardiac rehab has two essential parts: exercise counseling and training and



education for heart-healthy living. At Sheridan Memorial Hospital's cardiac rehab program, you'll partner with our team of nurses and exercise specialists to take charge of the choices, lifestyle, and habits that affect your heart.

daily assistance, physical/occupational/speech therapy, assistance with wound and ostomy care, post-operative assessment and care, physical and emotional assessment, and personal care.

Extensive training and knowledge of the entire human body gives our providers the leading edge in diagnostic care. Internists are often called upon by other medical professionals for their ability to solve undetermined health problems. Their expertise makes them vital both to patients and medical professionals.

These inflammatory and autoimmune diseases affect your musculoskeletal system including joints, muscles, tendons, and ligaments. Rheumatic disease and similar conditions can be complex, and our collaborative care network led by specialists is here for your benefit. Each patient receives a personalized

#### **WELCH CANCER CENTER**

At the Welch Cancer Center, we give our patients personalized attention and care rooted in kindness and compassion. # **OUR HEALTHCARE SERVICES**



#### **EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT**

Accidents and illnesses can affect any person at any time. That's why our Emergency Department provides 24-hour coverage for all age groups. We have a physician in our Emergency Department every hour – day and night. Our Emergency Department is designated as an Area Trauma Hospital by the Wyoming Trauma Program, Wyoming Department of Health. This means our team has demonstrated an ability to provide prompt



assessment, resuscitation, surgery, intensive care, and stabilization of injured patients and emergency operations. Regions where a functioning trauma system exists show a significant decrease in preventable deaths among severely injured patients.





#### **INTENSIVE CARE UNIT (ICU)**

Our Intensive Care Unit team includes highly-trained physicians and nurses to take care of you or your loved ones during a critical illness. We understand a critical illness and a stay in the ICU can be one of the most stressful times in your life and we want to help lessen the burden. With the new state-of-the-art ICU at Sheridan Memorial Hospital, we can take care of sicker patients right here at home, close to family and loved ones. The ICU has 11 rooms, each with a private bathroom, window, and cutting-edge technology to provide you with optimal patient care. We recognize when you are ill, it is an important part of



your healing process to have your family and loved ones around you. With this in mind, each room has space for loved ones to be close by and part of your care to help achieve the best possible outcome.



#### **HOSPITAL MEDICINE (MED/SURG)**

If you are admitted to Sheridan Memorial Hospital as a patient, your personal physician may request our hospitalist service to manage some or all of your care during your hospital stay. Our hospitalist team is made up of physicians, physician assistants, and nurse practitioners who are based in the hospital seven days a week to exclusively provide care to hospitalized patients.

# **OUR HEALTHCARE SERVICES** (HOSPITAL)

#### TRANSITIONAL CARE UNIT

A Transitional Care Unit (TCU) is a recuperative and supportive place to heal following an injury, surgery, or serious illness. From changes to one's daily schedule to the adjustments necessary to return home – our care team of nurses, doctors, and therapists manage transitions and help you or your family member regain a level of independence for a safe return home. Our new TCU has 20 private suites designed for the comfort of our patients.



Each spacious suite has its own bathroom. The unit has a separate dining area and spacious therapy gym – both with striking views of the Bighorn Mountains from the second and third floors of the hospital building.

#### **URGENT CARE**

We know your life is hectic. That's why SMH Urgent Care offers multiple appointment types to accommodate you and your family. You can reserve your spot in advance, just walk in, or make a telemedicine appointment to fit your schedule wherever you may be. We also offer a convenient take-home medication service that sends the prescription medications you need to feel better with you at the end of your visit – no extra stops or waits on your way home. Our Urgent Care offers a comfortable waiting room with free Wi-Fi and 10 treatment



rooms. X-rays, EKGs, and labs are available onsite. We also perform a variety of procedures such as suturing, draining abscesses, splinting, trigger-point injections, and wart or skin lesion removals. As part of the Sheridan Memorial Hospital system, our records are available to all SMH clinics.



#### OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AT URGENT CARE

As an employer, you want your employees to be healthy and safe. At Urgent Care, we



provide services in the areas of wellness and occupational health. Our occupational health program offers pre-employment testing, drug screening, and work illness and injury treatment services. Onsite services include emergency and urgent care services, radiology, laboratory, and pharmacy.

### OUR HEALTHCARE SERVICES (HOSPITAL)

#### RADIOLOGY / MAMMOGRAPHY

We offer medical imaging services for inpatients and for those who need outpatient and emergency services. Our state-of-the-art equipment and technology, coupled with our experienced and caring staff provide you with the best care right here at home. At SMH, our medical imaging services are located both within the hospital and in the adjoining Outpatient Center. Services include CT (computed tomography, also known as CAT Scan),



interventional radiology, MRI (magnetic resonance imaging), ultrasound, nuclear medicine, X-Ray/fluoroscopy, outpatient radiology services, mammography, bone densitometry (DEXA Scan), and stereotactic breast biopsy.



#### LABORATORY – HEALTHELIFE FRIDAYS / OUTPATIENT LAB

Our patient-directed lab testing (formerly called Wellness Blood Screenings) is done on HealtheLife Fridays – the third Friday of each month at the hospital's Primary Care Clinic in downtown Sheridan at 61 South Gould Street. These annual screening tests include: blood



chemistry panel, CBC, PSA, HA1C, and Vitamin D. HealtheLife blood draws are patient-directed, so you will receive your results via MySheridanHealth – our Patient Portal – or via mail if requested.



#### **NUTRITIONAL SERVICES**

Our cafeteria and the Sidewalk Cafe are open to the public. We believe access to nutritious, freshly prepared food is an important part of wellness. Whether you are a patient or just visiting, you will soon find Sheridan Memorial Hospital's food service offers an excellent selection of high-quality options to meet your dietary needs. We are extremely proud of our reputation and all patient menu items are prepared in-house daily, using local produce whenever available and only Choice or Select meats. In addition, salads are prepped fresh



daily and soups, sauces, and desserts are made from scratch. Our patients can take advantage of our room service option to eat when it is convenient for them. As a visitor, you can order an extra meal from room service to eat with your loved one.

#### FINANCIAL SERVICES - FINANCIAL ADVOCATES / MAP

At Sheridan Memorial Hospital and Clinics, we are committed to extending financial assistance to qualified individuals. We assist underinsured and uninsured patients in navigating federal and state health insurance programs and help enroll those patients in the programs for which they are eligible. Our team includes financial counselors who assist you and your family in determining eligibility and through the application process. We have also taken additional steps to build a convenient and patient-friendly process that maxi-



mizes enrollment in certain government-sponsored health insurance programs, including Medicaid. MAP, our Medication Assistance Program, assists uninsured and underinsured patients in locating and enrolling in affordable or free medication programs.
