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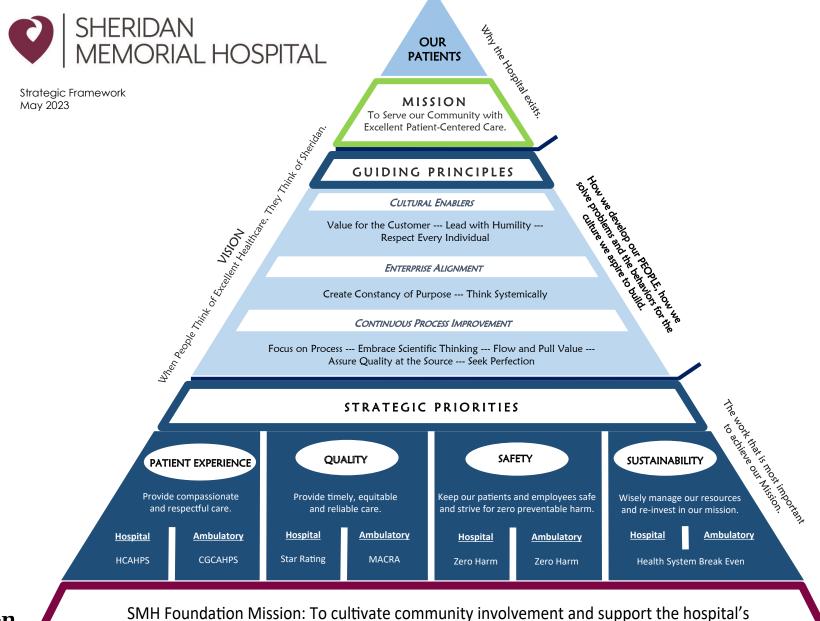

CONFLICT OF INTEREST

POLICY: The Foundation Board of Directors and Staff shall avoid conflicts of interest.

<u>PROCEDURES/CONDITIONS</u>: The following conditions apply:

- In all matters, which involve donors or prospective donors, the donor interest shall be paramount to that of the Foundation.
- No program, agreement, trust, contract or commitment shall be urged upon any donor or prospective donor which would benefit the Foundation at the expense of the donor's interest.
- No agreement shall be made between the Foundation and any agency, person, company or organization on any matter, whether investments, management or otherwise, which would knowingly jeopardize the donor's interest.
- No part of the earnings or capital of the Foundation shall inure to the benefit of any Director or staff member.
- No Director or staff member shall benefit from the sale of products to the Foundation without the consent of the Board of Directors.
- Directors will excuse themselves from discussion and voting when conflicts are identified.
- Should a potential conflict of interest be reported or identified, the Chief Development Officer will work with the Board President to evaluate the situation and determine a course of action to resolve the conflict.
- Board members will fill out a conflict of interest form annually.

Donor and Fundraising Development Committee

<u>Committee Mission</u>: The Donor and Fundraising Development Committee manages the ongoing donor development and fundraising strategies to meet the annual and long-term goals of the Sheridan Memorial Hospital (SMH) Foundation.

Accountability:

- The Donor and Fundraising Development Committee is a standing committee established annually by the Board of Directors.
- The Donor and Fundraising Development Committee reports to the Board of Directors.
- The Chair is to be determined by the Committee annually.

<u>Committee Composition and Terms of Service</u>:

- The Committee will have a minimum of three directors.
- The Committee may invite former directors or community members to join the committee.
- One Foundation Board Member will serve as the Legacy Liaison for the committee (see duties/responsibilities below).
- The Director of Donor Relations and Director of Philanthropy are assigned to serve on the committee.
- The Terms of Service will be one year, with opportunities for serving additional terms.

<u>Responsibilities (The Committee will...)</u>:

- Work with the Chief Development Officer, Director of Donor Relations and Director of Philanthropy to review the fundraising plan to ensure progress toward annual and long-term funding goals of the SMH Foundation.
- Set priorities for fundraising efforts; evaluate plans and strategies; and present outcomes to the Board of Directors, as appropriate.
- Work with the Director of Donor Relations and Director of Philanthropy to identify and solicit funds from external sources of support including, but not limited to: foundations, corporations, community organizations, and individuals.
- Support the organization through the planning and implementation of fundraising events and campaigns.
- Encourage participation by the full Board of Directors in fundraising efforts.
- Identify and recruit community leaders to serve on the Donor and Fundraising Development Committee.
- Engage in Donor Development Cycle: Cultivation, Solicitation, & Stewardship.

Committee Member Expectations:

- Attend and participate in Donor and Fundraising Development Committee meetings.
- Prepare adequately for meetings in order to make informed decisions.

<u>Time Commitment</u>: 4-5 hours per quarter (quarterly meeting plus donor development work as determined by the committee)

Legacy Liaison Roles/Responsibilities:

- One Foundation Board Member will serve in the role of Legacy Liaison focusing on the following areas:
 - Strengthening relationships with major donors through phone calls, tours and in person meetings.
 - Developing new relationships with prospective major donors through phone calls, tours and in person meetings.
 - Maintaining relationships with current and retired physicians through attendance at quarterly medical staff meetings, phone calls, tours and in person meetings.
 - Connecting Foundation board members with efforts to achieve Fund Development Goals.
 - Assisting Foundation Staff to strengthen the connection with the Sheridan Memorial Hospital Board by regularly attending board meetings and planning a bi-annual meeting between the hospital and Foundation boards.
 - Supporting planned giving programs/initiatives by delivering information and making connections with financial advisors, certified public accountants (CPAs), and lawyers.
- The Legacy Liaison will meet with the Chief Development Officer, Director of Donor Relations and Director of Philanthropy twice a month to develop and review plans for connections with major donors, physicians, and planned giving professionals.



Finance Committee

<u>Committee Mission</u>: The Finance Committee is responsible for the monitoring of Foundation Funds' performance, asset allocation, and associated fees on a quarterly basis to ensure compliance with the Investment Policy Statement (IPS).

Accountability:

- The Finance Committee is a standing committee established annually by the Board of Directors.
- The Finance Committee reports to the Board of Directors.
- The Chair is to be SMH Foundation Treasurer.

Committee Composition and Terms of Service:

- The Committee will be comprised of a minimum of two voting board members.
- The Chief Development Officer and Director of Donor Relations are assigned to serve on the committee.
- The Terms of Service will coincide with the terms of office.

Responsibilities (The Committee will...):

- Work with the Chief Development Officer and Director of Donor Relations to ensure that the financial goals established in the Foundation's Investment Policy Statement (IPS) are being met.
- Maintain oversight of the investment of the Funds of the Sheridan Memorial Hospital Foundation in accordance with the Foundation's IPS and may delegate investment authority to the external investment advisors who may be retained by the Board upon recommendation by the Finance Committee.
- Provide all external advisors with the most recent copy of the Foundation's IPS.
- Evaluate the external investment advisors on an as needed basis.

Committee Member Expectations:

- Attend and participate in Finance Committee meetings.
- Prepare adequately for meetings in order to make informed decisions.

<u>Time Commitment</u>: 4-5 hours per quarter (quarterly meeting plus additional work as determined by the committee)



Governance Committee

<u>Committee Mission</u>: The Governance Committee manages the ongoing review of policies, board development/education, and board recruitment to meet the goals of the Sheridan Memorial Hospital (SMH) Foundation.

Accountability:

- The Governance Committee is a appointed committee established by the Board of Directors.
- The Governance Committee reports to the Board of Directors.
- The Chair is to be determined by the Committee annually.

<u>Committee Composition and Terms of Service</u>:

- The Committee will have a minimum of three directors appointed by the Foundation President
- The Committee may invite emeritus directors or community members to join the committee.
- The Committee will include assigned Foundation staff to serve on the committee.
- The Terms of Service will be one year, with opportunities for serving additional terms.

<u>Responsibilities (The Committee will...)</u>:

- Work with the Foundation staff to review the bylaws and policies on an annual basis.
- Recommend revisions to policies, practices, and bylaws as needed.
- Establish an annual calendar for board development and education.
- Coordinate board recruitment to ensure the board recruits and retains leaders that represent a broad range of demographics (expertise, skills, connections, age, gender, etc.) within our community.
- Provide annual training outlining the importance of developing, maintaining and following board policies as a means of ensuring effective governance.

Committee Member Expectations:

- Attend and participate in Governance Committee meetings.
- Prepare adequately for meetings in order to make informed decisions.

WELCOME:

Rob Johnson called the meeting to order at 4:00 pm and welcomed everyone.

REPORT FROM THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE

NEW BOARD MEMBERS (action):

President Rob Johnson called on Sue Belish, member of the Nominating Committee, to give a report of the nominations for the new board members.

Sue Belish recommended Gary Campbell and Mikole Bede Soto as new board members to serve 3-year-at-large terms replacing Rob Johnson and Vicki Jorgenson.

Rob Johnson opened the floor for additional names to put before the Foundation Board of Directors. Since there were none, Rob entertained a motion to approve Gary Campbell and Mikole Bede Soto as new board directors for a 3-year at-large terms.

RYAN FRANKLIN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE GARY CAMPBELL AND MIKOLE BEDE SOTO, FOR THREE-YEAR TERMS ON THE FOUNDATION BOARD OF DIRECTORS BEGINNING JULY 23, 2024 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2027. YVONNE GATLEY SECONDED AND THE MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

2ND TERM BOARD MEMBER (action):

Rob Johnson stated that Sue Belish has agreed to serve an additional 3-year at-large term to complete her 6 years of board service.

DR. DOUGHTY MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE SUE BELISH FOR A SECOND, THREE-YEAR TERM ON THE FOUNDATION BOARD OF DIRECTORS BEGINNING JULY 1, 2024 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2027.

ROSEMARY RIEDER SECONDED AND THE MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS (action):

Rob Johnson called Sue Belish, member of the Nominating Committee, to give a report on the slate of nominations for each office. On behalf of the Nomination Committee, Sue Belish submitted the following officer nominations for the 2025 Fiscal Year:

President: Sue Belish
Vice-President: Wendy Smith
Secretary: Yvonne Gatley
Treasurer: Chuck Burgess

Rob Johnson opened nominations from the floor. No further nominations came forward from the assembly so Rob called for a motion for the stated slate of officers for 2025 Fiscal Year.

RYAN FRANKLIN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE ABOVE SLATE OF OFFICERS FOR THE 2025 FISCAL YEAR. DR. DOUGHTY SECONDED THE MOTION AND THE MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Rob Johnson congratulated Sue, as President, and turned over the gavel to her to run the remainder of the meeting.

CORPORATE RESOLUTION (action):

Sue Belish stated that the financial institutions needed to be updated to reflect the change of Board Members and read the following resolution.

"Be it resolved that Rob Johnson, having completed his role as president on the Sheridan Memorial Hospital Foundation Board, and Vicki Jorgenson, having completed her role as Secretary, be removed from all signature documents at First Federal Bank and Trust, D. A. Davidson, and First Interstate Bank and any other accounts associated with the Sheridan Memorial Hospital Foundation; and that the Fiscal Year 2025 officers, Sue Belish, Wendy Smith, Chuck Burgess and Yvonne Gatley, as well as Ada Kirven and/or Cody Sinclair to be authorized to sign all financial documents to all Sheridan Memorial Hospital Foundation accounts at First Federal Bank and Trust, D. A. Davidson and First Interstate Bank and any other accounts associated with the Sheridan Memorial Hospital Foundation as of July 23, 2024."

Sue Belish asked for a motion to approve the Corporate Resolution as presented.

RYAN FRANKLIN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE ABOVE CORPORATE RESOLUTION AS STATED. CHUCK BURGESS SECONDED AND THE MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOULSY.

BYLAW REVISION (action)

Sue Belish introduced the proposed amendments to Bylaws Article XV and asked Cody Sinclair, the Chief Development Officer, to further explain the change. In the process of reviewing and updating policies, the bylaws were reviewed to ensure the bylaws were accurate and consistent with the proposed policy recommendations. It was determined that changes were needed as to how bylaws are updated as membership has changed and grown over the years. The Foundation is proposing a

change to its Bylaws to allow for an efficient process to update bylaws while still allowing comments from general membership.

Sue Belish asked for a motion from the board to approve the Bylaw Revision as presented.

WENDY SMITH MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE BY-LAW REVISION AS PRESENTED. DR. DOUGHTY SECONDED AND THE MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOULSY.

CONSENT AGENDA (Action):

Sue Belish presented the two items on the consent agenda (June 25, 2024 meeting minutes and June 2024 Checks, Transfers, and Journal Entries) and called for a motion. There were no questions or concerns.

CHUCK BURGESS MOVED TO APPROVE THE CONSENT AGENDA, WENDY SMITH SECONDED THE MOTION. THE MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

FOUNDATION YEAR IN REVIEW EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Rob Johnson presented the review of the Foundation & Executive Committee. He shared that the Growing for You – Behavioral Health & Emergency Department Campaign had a Quiet Phase launched in the spring of 2023. To date, 150 donors have contributed \$5,584,657. The total contributions to Sheridan Memorial Hospital in FY24 were \$4,352,714 which enabled multiple pieces of equipment to be purchased and upgrades to numerous areas. The connections also were strengthened and expanded in FY24 with Total Donors: 1,316 (gave \$6,436,349.68 an increase of \$2M from FY23) and total New Donors: 322 (gave \$328k an increase of \$59k from FY23).

COMMITTEE CHAIRS

- Donor & Fundraising Development Committee Chair, Dr. Bill Doughty, reviewed the 2024
 Donor and Fundraising Development. The committee spearheaded the Growing for You –
 Behavioral Health & Emergency Medicine campaign that has been very successful to date \$5,584,657 as of June 30, 2024.; supported Foundation Board and Staff to more than double
 the fundraising goal for this fiscal year (\$900k goal, but raised over \$2M); added members to
 the Donor & Fundraising Development Committee; and supported The Foundation staff in
 creating a Growing for You Community Interest Committee of approximately 40
 community members.
- Finance Committee Chair (and Foundation Treasurer), Chuck Burgess, presented the financial review for 2024. Quarterly committee reviews of the market revealed that the one year aggregate performance of all accounts was 14.0% which was well above the Investment Policy Statement goal of 7.98% (12 month CPI-U+5%); annual review of the Investment Policy Statement (IPS) and made updates to the IPS; Assisted in update to the Husman Funds to ensure the principal continues to support donor's intent to support dialysis and cardiology into the future, while allowing The Foundation Board to support other hospital needs when dialysis and cardiology needs are being adequately addressed; and added a section for Chief Development Officer responsibilities.

• Governance Committee Chair (and Foundation President), Sue Belish, presented a short review of 2024. The Bylaws were reviewed and updated; the Foundation policies were reviewed and updated with a template for future policies; updated the Directors Network and Expertise Matrix; continued to update a strong list of future candidates for director openings; ensured that compliance with policies and responsibilities were met; and completed a self-evaluation of the board.

SHERIDAN MEMORIAL HOSPITAL LEADERSHIP REMARKS- MIKE MCCAFFERTY

Sheridan Memorial Hospital Chief Executive Officer Mike McCafferty, gave brief remarks during which he thanked The Foundation and Hospital Boards for their leadership and support. Mike thanked Rob and Vicki for their years on the Foundation Board. Mike also emphasized that the employees have a deep care for patients, community and family that allows the hospital and The Foundation to continue the mission of excellent healthcare for the community.

FOUNDATION PRESENTATION OF NURSING AND CLINICAL SCHOLARSHIPS-ADA KIRVEN

Ada Kirven gave a brief history of the scholarship program and then presented the awards. Forty-five scholarships were awarded this year that totaled over \$85,000.00. The Clinical Endowment, was created in 2001, awarded over \$33,000 and the remaining amount was funded by The Foundation's Restricted Program & Unrestricted Funds to support our staff's efforts to provide excellent patient-centered care.

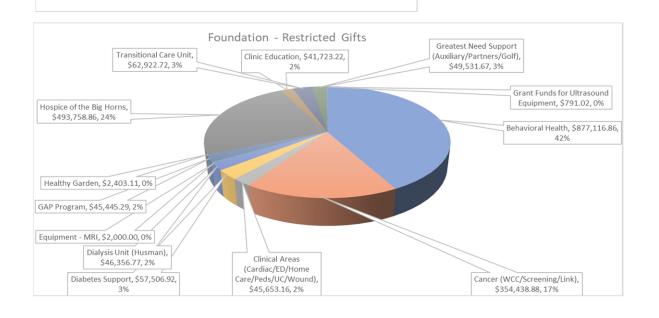
