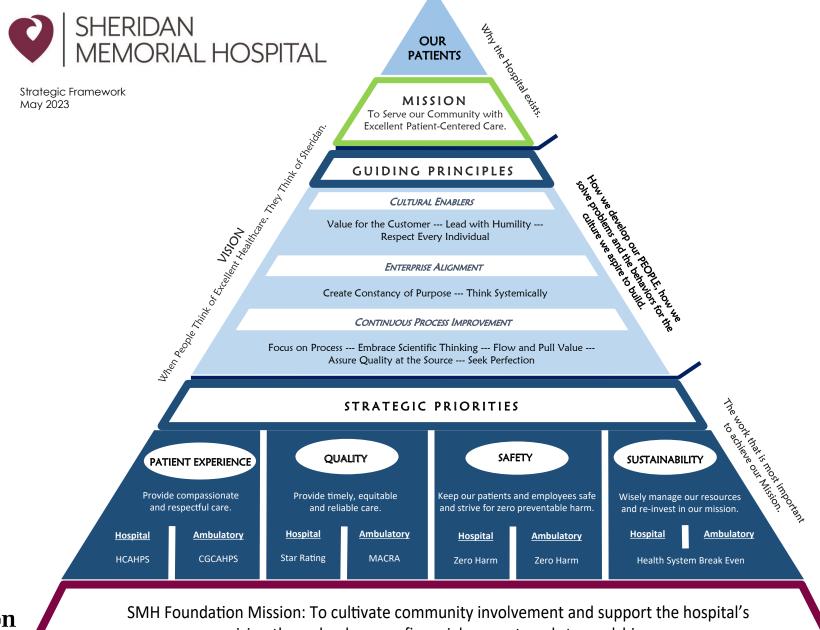

WELCOME:

President Sue Belish called the meeting to order at 3:57 pm and welcomed everyone. She reminded everyone to keep the SMH Foundation mission in mind to cultivate community involvement and support the hospital's vision.

CHANGE OF OFFICER POSITION FOR FY25 (action)

President Sue Belish asked Cody to explain the situation necessitating a change to the Treasurer position. Cody explained when moving funds in DA Davidson, it was realized that a conflict of interest existed with Chuck Burgess. Chuck is a broker and is involved in trading with other companies. Chuck can no longer be a signer on the accounts but he can still serve on the Finance committee and other committees.

Sue Belish shared that Ryan Franklin is willing to submit his name for consideration to fill the treasurer position. Sue asked if there are any other nominations for the treasurer position and no other nominations came forward. Sue Belish asked for a motion for Ryan Franklin to fill the Treasurer role for 2025 Fiscal Year.

GARY CAMPBELL MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE RYAN FRANKLIN AS THE TREASURER FOR THE 2025 FISCAL YEAR. WENDY SMITH SECONDED THE MOTION, AND IT CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

UPDATED CORPORTATE RESOLUTION (action)

Sue Belish stated with this change in Foundation leadership approved, the resolution for financial institutions needs to be updated. She read the resolution and asked for a motion from the board.

"Be it resolved that Chuck Burgess, having successfully served as treasurer on the Sheridan Memorial Hospital Foundation Board, be removed from all signature documents at First Federal Bank and Trust, D. A. Davidson, and First Interstate Bank and any other accounts associated with the Sheridan Memorial Hospital Foundation; and that the Fiscal Year 2025 officers be updated to include, Sue Belish, Wendy Smith, Ryan Franklin and Yvonne Gatley, as well as Ada Kirven and/or Cody Sinclair to be authorized to sign all financial documents to all Sheridan Memorial Hospital Foundation accounts at First Federal Bank and Trust, D. A. Davidson and First Interstate Bank and any other accounts associated with the Sheridan Memorial Hospital Foundation as of August 27, 2024."

Sheridan Memorial Hospital Foundation August 27, 2024 Regular Board Meeting Sue Belish asked for a motion to approve the Corporate Resolution as presented.

MIKOLE BEDE SOTO MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE ABOVE CORPORATE RESOLUTION AS STATED. WENDY SMITH SECONDED THE MOTION, AND IT CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

SHERIDAN MEMORIAL HOSPITAL UPDATE

Cody Sinclair introduced Ann Aksamit, Director of Nursing and previous Homecare & Hospice Manager. Ann discussed the history of Hospice and the evolution of the program. Ann then introduced Dr. Schamber who is the medical director that oversees hospice and home care. Currently, the Hospice program serves approximately 75 families annually, which has increased from past years because of the contracts with Westview Health Care and Big Horn Rehabilitation and Care Center.

Ann would like to request funding from the Foundation for the Hospice program. The money is needed to provide education, support materials, and to furnish a room at Westview to create a more home like atmosphere for SMH Hospice patients receiving end of life care in that facility.

PHILANTHROPIC STORY

Ada Kirven discussed the history of Hospice Funds. The Hospice Fund has been supported by our community for many years. The fund has grown to approximately \$500,000.00 as shown on page twenty-nine and thirty of the July 2024 Board packet. Our community loves the Hospice program and has been very generous with gifts toward this program.

FUNDRAISING/PHILANTHROPY BEST PRACTICE:

Cody Sinclair discussed the Conflict of Interest on page two of the board packet. The emphasis is to have the interest of donors at the forefront. If conflicts exist, please excuse yourself from voting and let the President and/or CDO know. A Conflict of Interest form must completed and returned to the Foundation office as soon as possible.

Sue Belish discussed the solicitation of Board of Directors to Join Board Committees. The committees usually meet every quarter and Directors are encouraged to serve on at least one committee. During the September Board meeting, Sue will assign Directors to specific committees. The Finance Committee has two members, Governance Committee has three members, and the Executive Committee is made up of the four officers.

CONSENT AGENDA (action):

Sue Belish presented the two items on the consent agenda (July 23, 2024 meeting minutes and July 2024 Checks, Transfers, and Journal Entries) and called for a motion. There were no questions or concerns.

RYAN FRANKLIN MOVED TO APPROVE THE CONSENT AGENDA. GARY CAMPBELL SECONDED THE MOTION. THE MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Sheridan Memorial Hospital Foundation August 27, 2024 Regular Board Meeting

FOUNDATION REPORTS

Ada Kirven discussed the request for Hospice Program Support of \$22,000.00 from the Hospice of the Big Horn Fund. A list of the items requested is located on page 22 of the Board packet.

Sue Belish proposed the acceptance of the \$22,000.00 request for FY25 from the Hospice of the Big Horn Funds.

RYAN FRANKLIN MOVED TO APPROVE THE TRANSFER OF \$22,000.00 FROM THE HOSPICE OF THE BIG HORN FUNDS. ROSEMARY RIEDER SECONDED THE MOTION. THE MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Ada gave an update on Donor relations as seen on page 23. In July 2024, there were 27 new donors, 6 major gifts, and \$74,376.88 received in new cash/stock.

Liz Dearcorn reviewed the Roadmap for Philanthropic Support for the SMH's Strategic Plan on page 25. As of July 31, 2024, the remodel for the pharmacy and the supply department is completed and is under budget projections. The Pediatrics unit is under demolition with completion date early next year. The Griffith Emergency Department remodel has begun and is in the first phase. The remaining amount to be raised for the Growing for You Campaign by the Foundation is \$353,143.00.

Jasmine Slater gave the Community Coordination, Event & Volunteer updates. The following events are:

"100 donors in a 100 days" Campaign began August 26, 2024 and will continue to December 4, 2024. The campaign aims to bring the community together to support the development of behavioral health.

Born in a Barn will be September 13 and 14, 2024. Volunteers will assist The Mimosa Mafia to raise money for the Welch Cancer Center. Last year their team raised over \$19,000.00 and this year hope to raise over \$20,000.00. Additional Volunteers are still needed for the event.

The Welch Cancer Center is replacing the Linear Accelerator (LINAC), which is the equipment that gives the radiation treatments for cancer patients. In order to give seamless care for the patients needing radiation, Comfort Care Funds will cover the costs of travel, gas, lodging and food. The replacement time line for the LINAC is 6-8 weeks.

REPORTS

SMH AUXILIARY- ROSEMARY RIEDER

Rosemary shared that the 5-year-old Birthday Party will be in September.

SMH PHYSICIANS- DR.JOSH SCOTT

Dr. Scott shared that two new physicians have joined the SMH Staff. Dr Turnbough, a Rheumatologist, and Dr. Kim, an Oncologist, are welcomed additions to the staff.

SMH BOARD OF TRUSTEES REPORT- RICHARD GARBER

Richard Garber shared that Wyoming is the most philanthropic state in the country. He also mentioned that the hospital will continue to support the Green House Living and will continue to search for the right people for the right positions.

OTHER BUSINESS

Sue Belish suggested moving the board meetings to the fourth Monday of each month because of conflicts with Tuesdays. The Board members were all in favor of moving the day to the fourth Monday of each month. The next Board meeting will be Monday, September 23, 2024 at 4:00 P.M.in the SMH Cafeteria Conference Room C.


