2000

- 2000: Patient wing expansion completed with a community philanthropy effort of \$3 million.

- 2007: Watt Dialysis Center opened, thanks to the generous donation by The Joe & Arlene Watt Foundation and support from the Bob Bishop Dialysis Endowment.

2010

- 2013: Welch Cancer Center celebrated its grand opening, thanks to \$6 million in community support, allowing for cancer diagnosis and treatment.
- 2016: Intensive Care Unit opened, expanding capacity from six to 11 private rooms, which became pivotal to our community's health during the pandemic.

2020

- 2027: Behavioral Health Unit to open.




