SUPPORTING OUR COMMUNITY

PROVIDING QUALITY CARE TO EVERYONE

Nobody is turned away at Sheridan Memorial Hospital. SMH is a community hospital committed to serving the Sheridan area with excellent patient-centered care. This commitment is easily demonstrated in the total amount of unreimbursed care provided by Sheridan Memorial Hospital during the past year.

Medical Assistance — \$856,692

This includes the cost of services rendered that are not billed due to patients qualifying for medical assistance under the SMH Medical Assistance Policy, which is based on federal poverty limit quidelines.

Subsidized Health Services — \$7,837,143

SMH offers a host of provider clinics specializing in care from family medicine to rheumatology. Having these providers in the community is essential to caring for our local residents and the costs of running these clinics is often not covered by Medicare and insurance payers.

Bad Debt — \$3,764,619

This represents the cost of services provided to patients who are unable or unwilling to pay their bills despite our efforts to collect payment. These patients may not have participated in or qualified for medical assistance under the SMH Medical Assistance Policy.

Unpaid Cost of Medicare/Medicaid — \$23,967,920

This represents the gap between the actual cost of care and the amount reimbursed by these government programs.

TOTAL COMMUNITY BENEFIT — \$36,426,374

EFFICIENT USE OF HEALTHCARE DOLLARS

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) collect data regarding the amount spent per Medicare beneficiary in every county across the US. Currently, Sheridan County ranks in the top 0.07% of hospitals in the nation for having the lowest cost per beneficiary.

Sheridan County is:

- Lowest in WY
- Top 0.07% in the US

Sheridan County ranks 3,124 out of 3,146 counties in the United States, making it the 22nd lowest-ranked county.

FREE FINANCIAL ADVOCACY

Sheridan Memorial Hospital and clinics are committed to extending financial assistance to qualified individuals. We assist underinsured and uninsured patients in navigating federal and state health insurance programs and we help enroll those patients in the programs for which they are eligible.

SMH provides financial counselors who assist patients to determine eligibility and to complete the application process. We have also taken additional steps to build a convenient and patient-friendly process that maximizes enrollment in certain government-sponsored health insurance programs, including Medicaid.

Marketplace: Affordable insurance plans offered through healthcare.gov

LINK: Advocates facilitate the application and approval process for LINK funding through the SMH Foundation for cancer screening and diagnostic testing.

Medication assistance: Co-pay assistance and free medication based on health insurance coverage and household financial status.

Grant assistance: Advocates find available grant funding to assist with medical expenses.

WHAT OUR PATIENTS SAY

CHARLES GIBSON — Transitional Care Unit

At 91, Charlie Gibson faced a series of health challenges, including prostate and kidney cancer, and a severe urinary tract infection. However, his resilience shone through during his recovery at Sheridan Memorial Hospital's Transitional Care Unit. The team, inspired by his determination, organized a "decathlon" featuring adapted exercises, which became a highlight of his stay. Gibson's recovery journey emphasized not just physical therapy, but also the importance of positivity, laughter and accepting challenges.

"Don't just lay around. You don't get well doing that. You need someone to kick you in the butt every day and get you moving," he said.







BRENT WEAVER — Addiction & Internal Medicine

Brent Weaver's journey with addiction began with early experimentation and rebellion. After struggling with substance abuse for years, he found himself at rock bottom. Recognizing the need for drastic change, he sought treatment at Sheridan Memorial Hospital. Through the supportive programs at SMH and the guidance of peer specialists like himself, Weaver has successfully maintained sobriety and now dedicates his life to helping others on their recovery path.

"When you first come into recovery, you're a shattered person," he said.

"There is so much guilt and shame that you carry into the doors when you first want help. If you're sitting across from someone who has been in a similar position, who isn't judging you, who understands, you have more belief in yourself that you can make a change. You don't feel alone."
