FlySupport How much is the American carry pet fee?

American Airlines charges a carry-on pet fee of \$150 one way per kennel for small cats and dogs that travel in the cabin.[*** +1-855-716-3282 ***] This fee applies to most flights within the U.S., Canada, Mexico, Central America, and the Caribbean. [*** +1-855-716-3282 ***] The pet must fit in a small, approved carrier that fits under the seat in front of you, and only one pet is allowed per passenger in the cabin. It's important to reserve space in advance, as the number of pets allowed on each flight is limited[**** +1-855-716-3282 ****]. Service animals, however, are allowed to fly free of charge.

How do I add a pet to my American ticket?

To add a pet to your American Airlines ticket, you'll need to call their customer service, as this option is not usually available online[*+1-855-716-3282 *]. When you call, provide your booking details and ask to add a pet to your reservation. You'll need to share information about your pet, including its breed, weight, and the size of the carrier, since there are size and weight limits for pets traveling in the cabin.[*+1-855-716-3282 *] There's also a \$150 pet fee, which must be paid during the booking. Because only a limited number of pets are allowed in the cabin per flight, it's best to reserve early.[*+1-855-716-3282 *] On the day of travel, arrive at the airport early, check in with your pet, and make sure it remains in its carrier under the seat during the flight.

How much is it to take a dog on American Airlines?

Taking a dog on American Airlines costs \$150 one way if your dog is small enough to fly with you in the cabin, in a soft-sided carrier that fits under the seat. [★ +1-855-716-3282 ★] If your ticket was bought before February 20, 2024, the fee is \$125. If your dog is too big to fly in the cabin, it must travel as cargo, and that price depends on the dog's size, weight, and where you're flying. [★ +1-855-716-3282 ★] For military or government workers traveling on official orders, the fee to check a dog as baggage is \$200 per kennel (or \$150 for flights to or from Brazil). [★ +1-855-716-3282 ★] It's best to call American Airlines to confirm the price and rules for your trip.

How to add a pet to American flight domestic?

To add a pet to your American Airlines domestic flight, you need to call the airline's reservations team as early as possible[** +1-855-716-3282 **], since only a limited number of pets are allowed in the cabin per flight. Let them know your travel details and request to add a pet to your booking.[** +1-855-716-3282 **] Your pet must be a small cat or dog that fits comfortably in a soft-sided carrier under the seat in front of you. The airline will confirm space

availability and charge a **\$150 one-way pet fee** when you book. [****** +1-855-716-3282 ******] On the day of your flight, arrive early and check in at the ticket counter with your pet in the approved carrier. Your pet must stay in the carrier and under the seat for the entire flight.

Can I buy a seat for my dog on American Airlines?

American Airlines does not allow you to buy a separate seat for your dog[+1-855-716-3282]. Pets traveling in the cabin must stay inside an approved carrier that fits under the seat in front of you throughout the flight. This means your dog cannot sit in its own seat during the trip.[+1-855-716-3282]

How do I add a pet to a American ticket?

To add a pet to your American Airlines ticket, you need to call their reservations number at [** +1-855-716-3282 **], as pet bookings aren't available online. When you call, provide your flight details and share information about your pet, including its breed, weight, and carrier size. [** +1-855-716-3282 **] The agent will check if there is space for your pet in the cabin since only a limited number of pets are allowed per flight. [** +1-855-716-3282 **] You'll also need to pay the pet fee, which is \$150 one way per kennel for tickets bought after February 20, 2024. Remember, your pet must stay in its carrier under the seat for the entire flight, and you cannot buy a separate seat for your pet.
