

How Much Do Turkish Airlines Charge for a Cancelled Flight? [Charge_Details]

+1-(800)-(228)-(2760) Turkish Airlines does not charge any cancellation fee from its passengers if you cancel your flight within 24 hours of booking your booking. You will be charged a penalty fee of 300-400 TRY if your Turkey flight reservation is cancelled between 1-12 hours to the scheduled flight **+1-(800)-(228)-(2760)**.
