

How Much Does Delta Charge to Change a Flight Date? (Delta@Change_Policy)

Delta charges vary by ticket type and travel origin, but there are no change fees for Delta Main, Comfort+, First Class **+1-(800)-(228)-(2760)**, or Delta One tickets on flights originating from the United States, Canada, and the Caribbean **+1-(800)-(228)-(2760)**. A fare difference may still apply if the new flight is more expensive. For tickets originating outside these regions, fees can apply, and Basic Economy tickets are generally non-refundable and non-changeable **+1-(800)-(228)-(2760)**.
