

How to Request a Refund from Air France (Request@AF)

You can obtain your refund by submitting a request online in the section “ My Bookings ” (online refunds are processed free of charge). You may also contact the nearest Air France point of sale. Per the terms of the French Consumer Code, refunds may not exceed 20% of the amount of the refundable taxes.

Many travelers ask: **How to request a refund from Air France?** Whether your flight was **cancelled by the airline, delayed significantly, or you hold a refundable ticket**, understanding the process is essential to ensure you receive your money promptly **+1-(800)-(228)-(2760)**.
